<u>3. CBC PROGRAMMES:</u>

We have had a lot of CBC assessment activities this term. We really appreciate your continued support in ensuring that your child reaps maximum benefits from the unique learning experiences. The assessment outcomes have been uploaded to the KNEC Competence Based Assessment portal.

4. INTERVIEWS:

We shall conduct assessments for admission of **day scholars only** on **23rd September 2022** from **8:00 a.m.**. Those seeking a place at Fesbeth Academy can bring with them academic records from the previous school, a copy of birth certificate, a valid KNEC assessment number, writing materials and Ksh 1000 cash assessment fee.

5. JUNIOR SECONDARY SCHOOL

We are happy to inform you that our school is approved by the Ministry of Education to offer Grade. There is still window to make Fesbeth Academy your 1st choice for Grade 7 in January 2023. We welcome you next year.

6. UNIFORMS

All pupils should be in full school uniform that is well labelled using thread or printing. All boys **MUST** put on a tie. Tights for girls must be **BLACK** in colour. All boarders must have two full sweaters, a half sweater and our official fleece jacket. It is against our school rules to carry civilian clothes to boarding school.

7. BOARDING

Boarders should arrive **by 2 p.m** to avoid congestion at the registration desk. Class 7 and 8 are required to carry a ream of **printing paper**, **3 bars of Menengai soap** and 1 packet of **500g OMO**. No food is allowed into the dormitory apart from milk and fruits. Kindly label all boarding items of your child.

8. SMART ID

We have introduced Smart ID cards for Grade 1-7 boarders to be used from third term. The card will enable parents to receive phone alerts about pocket money usage, sickbay visits, clocking in and out of school, library use, indiscipline cases and financial balances. We plan to extend the same to all the pupils in the school.

<u>9. FEES</u>

Thank you so much for paying school fees promptly. Please pay school fees early to avoid inconveniences. Parents can make the payments on Paybill number **4073745**; Account name is your child's **Admission Number** with no spacing between the characters.
